Reformation

New exhibition celebrating 10th anniversary of White Rabbit Gallery



The White Rabbit Collection is one of the world's largest and most significant collections of contemporary Chinese art. Founded by Kerr and Judith Neilson, it focuses on works produced after 2000.

The origins of the Collection go back to the late 1990s, when Judith Neilson engaged Wang Zhiyuan, a Chinese artist then living in Sydney, as her art tutor. He introduced her to the astonishing explosion of creativity taking place in China in the wake of the "Opening Up" that had begun in 1989. Mrs Neilson began buying works, but soon ran out of space to hang them. She and her husband then decided to open a gallery that would make the exciting world of contemporary Chinese art available to all Australians.



The White Rabbit Gallery, a specially converted knitting factory near Sydney's Central Station, has four floors of exhibition space as well as a theatrette, a library and a teahouse. Only a fraction of the Collection is on show at any time. The entire contents of the gallery are rehung twice a year.

An excellent group tour has been organized.

The Brett Whiteley Gallery - Tour and Figure Drawing Workshop: Follow the Curve



The Brett Whiteley Studio, 2 Raper Street, Surry Hills, was the workplace and home of Australian artist, Brett Whiteley (1939–92). Since 1995 it has been managed as a museum by the Art Gallery of NSW

What to Bring?

- Photographic ID (student card/driving licence)
- Medicare card number
- Carry on luggage **only**. Suggest small backpack. **Height 56cm x Width 36cm x Depth 23cm**

Please do not be overweight/oversize as we have limited space on the transfer bus.

Cabin baggage

Only 1 (one) small item of hand luggage per person, weighing no more than 7kg and with dimensions of less than **Height 56cm x Width 36cm x Depth 23cm**, may be carried into the aircraft cabin. Any cabin baggage over 7kg will have to be carried in the hold of the aircraft and forms part of the total checked baggage allowance. **Students will have to pay for this themselves which will be expensive at check on, so plan and weigh your luggage BEFORE coming to the airport.** Passengers are also permitted to carry one small item E.g. camera/small tripod. We suggest you **DO NOT** take laptops or costly items. Total weight combined weight allowed 10kg.

Please limit your valuables. Bring a small lock for locker. Avoid bringing laptops.

- Shoes for walking (We will be doing a lot of walking in Sydney so have comfortable shoes).
- **Minimal** clothes for four days.
- PJ's
- Toiletries (towels provided)
- Ear plugs (if you are a light sleeper!)
- Camera /small lightweight tripod/ small torch
- Small sketchbook / pens/ pencils
- Protection for wet weather/rain

Miscellaneous costs:

- Local transport (please have change and student card).
- Lunch /dinner
- We will have a group dinner on the first night. Cost \$ 15 – 25.
- Other dinners at Manly and Doyles (famous fish restaurant – we eat at the take away.. but it's just as good and within your budget!) are optional.
- There is a kitchen at the youth hostel accommodation. You can make yourselves a packed lunch, tea etc.
- There are no costs involved with gallery entrance fees.

- Photography: In galleries please ask first before photographing artwork , as there may be a copyright issue.
- There is internet at the youth hostel, you need to purchase a card.
- Please keep to the itinerary. If you are late for flights, you are responsible for purchasing alternative transport.
- On some days there will be some walking, so please dress comfortably. Be prepared for winter weather. It can be cold at night.
- You will need to bring or hire a towel \$2.
